

Call for Expressions of Interest: Participation in Skills Development Programmes for the Funeral Services Sub-Sector

The Services Sector Education & Training Authority (Services SETA) is pleased to announce a **call for Expressions of Interest** from **registered employers and industry bodies/associations within the Funeral Services**. This initiative aims to establish partnerships with stakeholders to implement a range of skills development interventions designed to enhance the professionalisation and formalisation of the industry.

In alignment with the **National Skills Development Plan 2030** and the Services SETA's mandate, a number of occupational qualifications in the Funeral Services sub-sector have been developed and registered. These qualifications include Mortician, Embalmer, Embalmer's Assistant with Occupational Trades: Stonemason and Coffin Making still in-progress. The Services SETA seeks to collaborate with industry partners to implement training programmes that will address the skills gaps, promote the professional growth of the workforce and contribute to economic growth.

Also, the Services SETA's Accounting Authority, in the **2024/25 Sector Skills Plan**, Priority 2, commits to implement occupational qualifications in collaboration with the industry employers.

OBJECTIVES

The primary objectives of this call for expression of interest are to:

- 1. Partner with employers and industry bodies to implement learnerships, apprenticeships, skills programmes and Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) initiatives.
- 2. Upskill the workforce in the Funeral Services sub-sector to meet industry standards and legislative requirements.
- 3. Provide training opportunities for unemployed youth to enter the sector and potentially become future business owners.



ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Interested parties must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Be a registered employer or industry association/body within the Funeral Services subsector.
- 2. Demonstrate the capacity to support and implement the proposed training interventions.
- 3. Commit to providing a conducive learning environment for participants.
