This initiative aims to facilitate the ARPL process followed by the Trade Test for the identified learners who had completed their training through the City & Guilds qualifications.

**PROJECT OVERVIEW** 

This project is a critical component of the Services SETA's objectives for the current financial year and must be concluded by the end of March 2025. The Services SETA is committed to supporting a maximum of 200 learners, both employed and unemployed, who are spread across various provinces in South Africa.

SCOPE OF WORK:

The successful entity will conduct ARPL Assessments to evaluate the learners' prior learning and experience to determine their eligibility for the trade test. The entity will then administer and facilitate the trade testing process for the same learners to ensure they meet the required standards for certification.
