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In line with the Services SETA's mandate to facilitate skills development within the sector, Discretionary Grant (DG) funding is awarded for Learning Programme (LP) enrolments and completions. The Services SETA has recently conducted a performance analysis to establish pipeline shortfalls which might prevent it from achieving its 2025/26 Annual Performance Plan targets which are aligned to the Service Level Agreement (SLA) between the Services SETA and the Department of Higher Education and Training (DHET).

### 2. Scope and Targeted Entities

In order to address 2025/26 APP 4 DG Enrolment Performance Indicators (PIs) targets wherein Services SETA has a shortfall on, that is, Learnerships Unemployed (LP01), Learnerships Employed, (LP02) and Adult Education and Training (LP10), and, Skills Programme Employed (LP12), the Services SETA is hereby inviting its Sector Employers that submitted a Mandatory Grant (MG) Application in April or May of 2025. Applications for Services SETA and other SETA qualifications and HQ or OQ will be permitted.

This process should award 4,200 LP01 learners, 120 LP02 learners, 100 LP10 learners and 1,600 LP12 learners to resolve the pipeline shortfalls. See Annexure A for a detailed breakdown of Learning Programme qualification duration, credits, NQF levels and budget.

### 3. Who May Apply

Services SETA Sector Employers that submitted a Mandatory Grant (MG) Application in April or May of 2025. This targeted approach is intended recognise and give value to Sector Employers that are actively implementing skills development.

### 4. Eligibility Criteria

- Employers must be registered with SARS and pay the SDL (1% of their total payroll) if their annual payroll exceeds R500,000.
- Services SETA Sector alignment. The SDL must be allocated to the Services SETA sector.
- Learning Project Implementation Capacity:
  - Project Management capacity including securing of workplacement opportunities with host employers.
  - Administration capacity.
  - Human Resources capacity.

  - Learner termination rates (number of learners that terminated divided by the total number of learners).
  - Timely project closure (within how many working days after the last day of learning i.e. in classroom/workplace did your entity submit a project closure report with Certificates/Statement of Results attached where applicable).
