1. PURPOSE OF THIS PROJECT

APPOINTMENT OF A SERVICE PROVIDER TO CONDUCT ICT INFRASTRUCTURE SYSTEMS AND
BUSINESS APPLICATIONS ASSESSMENT AT THE SERVICES SETA

The purpose of this Terms of Reference (TOR) is to define the scope, objectives and deliverables for assessing the ICT infrastructure systems landscape and business applications environment within the Services SETA. This initiative aims to ensure that the organization's business systems, ICT operating model are aligned with the strategic goals of the organisation. Additionally, this exercise should also indicate the cost-effectiveness of operating the ICT systems and how effective such systems are in supporting business processes.

INTRODUCTION AND OVERALL OBJECTIVES

The Services Sector Education and Training Authority (Services SETA) was established and registered in March 2000 in terms of the Skills Development Act of 1998. The SETA aims to provide for the skills development needs of the services sector through the implementation of learnerships, disbursement of grants and monitoring of education and training.

The Services Sector Education and Training Authority (Services SETA) hereby invites quotes from experienced, knowledgeable service providers to submit proposals that aligns to the following key objectives:

- To compile a detailed inventory of all existing ICT infrastructure systems and business applications, their functionalities, and associated licensing agreements.
- To evaluate the alignment of current systems, with organizational goals and business processes.
- To identify gaps in system functionalities and areas where additional systems or upgrades are required.
- To assess duplication of functionalities, underutilization of systems, and inefficiencies in licensing agreements.
- To evaluate the integration and data flow gaps between systems, ensuring seamless operations and decision-making.
- To assess the effectiveness of the current ICT operating model, benchmarked against best practice framework and standards, in support of Service SETA Strategic objectives.
- To gather user feedback on existing systems to understand their effectiveness and identify areas for improvement, thereafter, construct Terms of Reference where additional systems are required.
- To provide actionable recommendations for optimizing the business applications environment, including potential cost savings and improved efficiency.

2. BACKGROUND

The Services SETA operates a mixed ICT estate model, relying on both internal and external resources for administration and technical support. The Service SETA's Intellectual property is mostly managed and controlled outside of Service SETA.

Over the past five years, the Services SETA ICT environment has transitioned from a **fragmented**, **unmanaged**, **and vendor-controlled landscape** (30+ disparate systems, no ICT governance, limited internal capacity and no system integration) to a phase of **consolidation and recovery**. Currently, ICT has been streamlined into a **limited number of core systems**, with major integration delivered through **Dynamics 365 Finance & Operations** and hosting migrated to the **Azure cloud**. This has strengthened ICT governance and brought critical business processes back in-house.

Looking ahead, the organization's strategic target is a digitally transformed, integrated ICT environment built on few sustainable and consolidated core business systems, in support of the Services SETA Integrated Information Management Systems (SSIIMS)

future state aims to deliver **seamless integration**, **fit-for-purpose systems**, **streamlined service delivery**, **strong governance**, **and reliable stakeholder engagement** through in-house system ownership and strategic vendor partnerships.

3. SCOPE OF WORK/ DELIVERABLES

3.1 The scope of this assessment includes, but is not limited to:

Inventory and Evaluation of Current Systems:

- Compile a comprehensive list of all ICT infrastructure systems and business applications in use,
- Document the purpose, functionalities, and users of each system.

- Assess licensing agreements, including costs, compliance, and utilization.
- Assess the relevance of each technology used in applications and infrastructure systems, based on trends and best practice standards
- Provide insight relating to system inventory & Lifecycle (i,e versions, support status, roadmap).
- Assess data architecture maturity, including data integration, quality, governance, records management, reporting, and alignment with regulatory requirements (e.g., POPIA, PAIA, National Treasury ICT Framework).

Gap Analysis:

- Identify missing functionalities or systems critical to achieving business goals.
- Highlight areas where systems fail to support business processes effectively.
- Identify undefined business processes critical to achieving business goals.
- Determine whether current system applications are effectively linked to business processes.
- Identify misalignments and deficiencies in technology, data flows, processes, governance, vendor arrangements, and user adoption that may hinder ICT's role as a strategic enabler.
- Identify gaps in the current ICT operating model leading to shortcomings in governance and deficiencies in service delivery.

- Analyse overlapping functionalities across systems.
- Assess the extent of underutilization of systems and licenses.
- Assess and document the utilization of unauthorized system licenses.

Integration and Data Flow:

- Evaluate the integration between business processes, systems, and the flow of data across the organizational departments.
- Identify inefficiencies, bottlenecks, or data silos and ineffective Application Programming Interface (API's).
- Document integration topology.
- Identify fragile links and duplication.
- Recommend target integration approach on Azure.

Regulatory and Compliance Review:

Ensure that all systems comply with legislative universe, industry regulations and organizational policies.

Risk Assessment:

- Identify risks associated with current systems, including cybersecurity vulnerabilities, disruptions, and unsupported software.
- Assess ICT risk maturity in line with potential cyber security threats

User Feedback and Training: User Experience and Adoption

Collect feedback from system users to understand pain points and improvement opportunities.

- Evaluate the adequacy of user training and support.
- Assess whether key systems are user-friendly.

Benchmarking:

- Compare current ICT infrastructure and applications systems with industry standards including sister entities.
- Compare current ICT operating model with industry standards including sister entities.

Sustainability and Scalability:

- Assess the ability of systems to scale with organizational growth or adapt to future needs.
- Assess the investment made over the past 5 years, whether a return on investment has been realised.

3.2. Key Deliverables

The appointed service provider will be required to deliver the following:

Comprehensive Systems Report:

- Detailed documentation of all current applications, including functionalities, integrations, and licensing.
- Identification of gaps, duplications, and underutilization.
- Document detailed terms of references for each system that has been proposed to be implemented, as informed by the assessment results.

Recommendations for Optimization:

- Suggestions for consolidating, upgrading, or retiring systems.
- Recommendations for investments in new systems, integrations, or training.
- Licensing recommendations to achieve cost savings and compliance.
- Recommend business processes to be defined or optimised to mitigate any gaps.

Proposed Roadmap:

- A clear roadmap with short, medium, and long-term goals for the ICT infrastructure systems and business applications
 environment with cost estimates
- Define future state of ICT (i.e integrated, streamlined, and strategically aligned ICT, with strong data governance, operating model in line with the SSIIMS Strategy)
- **Provide a comprehensive Change Management Plan** (i.e Guidance on engaging stakeholders and managing transitions).
- **Provide a comprehensive Risk Mitigation Plan** (i.e Strategies to address identified risks, including cybersecurity measures).
